## **Explanation of Responses:**

1. Represents automatic annual grant of performance shares (restricted stock units) to non-employee member of the Board of Directors (the "Board") pursuant to the Applied Materials, Inc. ("Applied") Employee Stock Incentive Plan. These performance shares are scheduled to vest in four equal annual installments beginning 3/1/11 (subject to continued service as a director through each vest date). Pursuant to Mr. Rogers' election, any shares that vest from this grant will be converted to shares of Applied common stock and paid to him on the date of his termination of service from the Applied Board.

2. Number of shares includes: (a) 5,422 performance shares that previously vested and which, pursuant to Mr. Rogers' election, will be converted to shares of Applied common stock and paid to him on the date of his termination of service from the Applied Board; and (b) 31,269 performance shares (restricted stock units) previously reported, of which (i) 15,000 shares will be converted in the future on a one-for-one basis into shares of Applied common stock upon vesting, which vesting is scheduled to occur in three equal installments beginning 4/27/10 and (ii) 16,269 shares are scheduled to vest in three equal annual installments beginning 3/1/11 and, pursuant to Mr. Rogers' election, will be converted to shares of Applied common stock and paid to him on the date of his termination of service from the Applied Board (all vesting is subject to continued service as a director through each vest date).
